The white oak is one of the most valuable trees in our woods. Oak trunks yield hard, water-resistant timber that is perfect for homes, furniture and boats. Not to mention bourbon barrels. Even as timber markets rise and fall, white oak staves are always in demand from breweries and distilleries.

That is why I am so concerned about the decline of oaks in Missouri. Current conditions in our woods favor other trees, making it harder for white oaks to take root and thrive. As our oaks die or are harvested, the forest that grows back will be of lower quality and value.



The good news is that we can step in now to give these trees a leg up, e.g., by reducing competitive species or doing patch cuts to let more light into the woods. Once established, white oaks are strong and long-lived, and their value grows over the years. But we must act now to ensure that these magnificent trees are there for our children and grandchildren.
